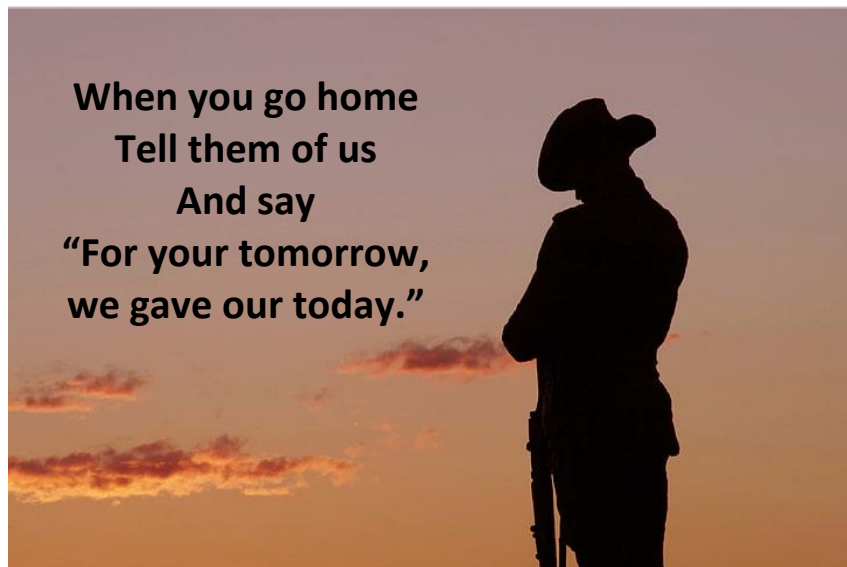




## What's been happening this week?
