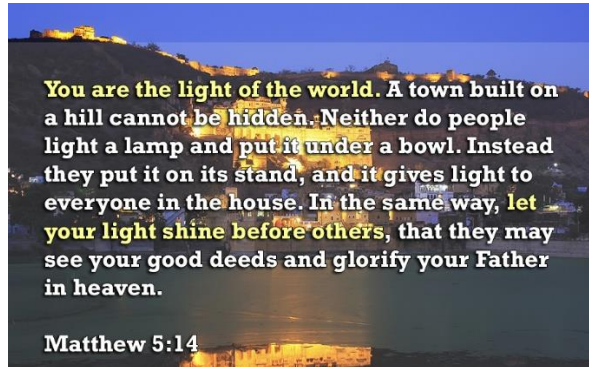

Kindy 2024 & 2025 – We are currently interviewing for Kindy 2024 classes and accepting applications for Kindy 2025. **If your child is born between 1 July 2019 and 30 June 2020, they are eligible to attend Kindy in 2024, and between 1 July 2020 and 30 June 2021 to attend Kindy in 2025.** Applications are available from the office or online.

Pre Kindy 2023 & 2024 – We are now taking enrolments for Pre Kindy 2023 and 2024. **We are pleased to announce this term we opened a Friday Pre Kindy Class.** Children can enrol for either Tuesday or Friday Pre Kindy or both days. Please note that your child must be a minimum of three years old to attend Pre Kindy. If you would like more information, please contact the school office.
