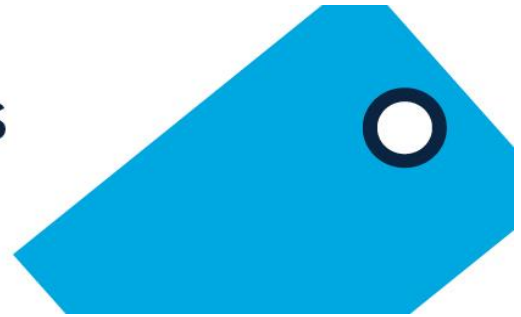

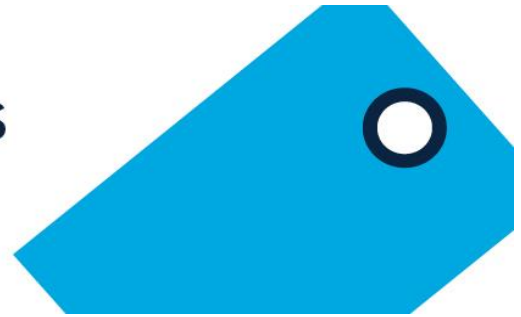

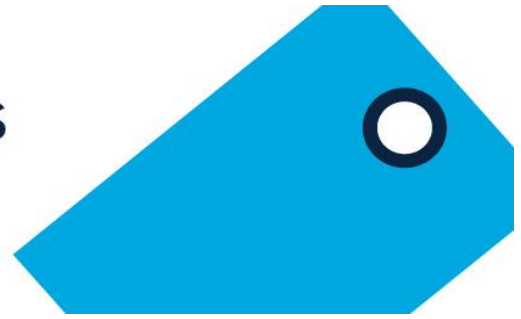

Children's Liturgy – We are excited to let you know that Children's Liturgy will be commencing monthly at our Lady's Assumption Parish, starting Sunday the 13 August and will run during the school term for children in Kindy to Year Three. The children need to be dropped off at the Parish Centre between 9:20-9:30am. The aim is to provide an experience that is enjoyable and more appropriate to their level of understanding.
