



I look forward to our community joining together for an array of celebrations tomorrow morning. From 7.45am to 8.15am, we warmly invite our fathers and father figures to join us for a Fathers' Day treat in the Presentation Centre. At 9am we invite our whole community to join us for Fathers' Day Mass. At 10.10am, our Athletics Carnival begins with a welcome in the Presentation Centre, before our students move out to begin the Year 3-6 200m races.

The carnival takes a "round robin" format. We warmly invite our parents to be actively involved by **following your children around to their different game stations.** You are most welcome to stand around the perimeter of the games to cheer your children on and move between the games to watch other children.

We ask you to support us by **remaining behind the bunting and cones at all times**. We also ask that you **please walk around the track**, **rather than across it to access games**.

The carnival will conclude at 2.55pm at the end of the presentations. At this time, **our students** will return to their classrooms to pack up and will be dismissed as usual at 3.05pm by their classroom teachers. Please note; all children must remain at school for the duration of the day.
