


Assumption Catholic Primary School NEWSLETTER - 26 October 2023

The teachers are finalizing class placements for 2024. Classroom placement at Assumption Catholic Primary School is a process that takes staff many hours of careful thought and consideration. When making classroom placements we always consider the individual child while recognizing that each child is also part of a complex equation. The primary purpose of the placement process is to create equitable classroom environments that allow teachers to meet academic, social and emotional needs of every student.

We continue to implement our Class Placement Procedure. As such, we respectfully ask that parents not request a particular teacher for their child. There are far too many interrelated factors to be considered when constructing a classroom to be able to accommodate specific teacher requests. Doing so is also very awkward for the teacher and it is very difficult to successfully build the most productive, balanced class groups on the basis of parent requests. The teachers spend many hours thinking about the best learning environment for all students and we ask that you trust our process.
